RULES GOVERNING REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS WHO PLAY IN LEAGUE MATCHES OF THE NORTH DEVON LEAGUE

Each club in membership of the League must REGISTER their players With the League Secretary prior to them playing in a North Devon League game.

- a. Registration will be on rolling or continual basis, meaning that once initial registration has taken place a player will be deemed to be a Registered Player for a club until such times as a Transfer takes place or an official written request is received by the Secretary requesting that a player be removed from a clubs list of registered players.
- b. Registration must be on the leagues prescribed form which must be completed in full and can be posted or hand delivered to the Secretary.
- c. The Secretary will send to each member club by the 28th of February each year a full list of their registered players as held by the league.
- d. Additions to a clubs registered players must be made to the Secretary as described in 4b above. Applications can be made at any time however during the season they must be made by 10am on the Thursday preceding a game should you wish the player to be included in a team or teams scheduled to play that weekend.
- e. Match day registration of a player or players is permitted by completing in full the leagues prescribed registration form which must then be signed by both captains of the day. The registration form must be returned to the League Secretary following the match.
- f. For the sake of clarity registering a player means the official notification to the Secretary of a player who you intend to play in a league game who has NOT played for or is NOT a registered player for any other member club in the league - if they have or are, then a Transfer (see 4i) must be carried out. It is important to note that care must be taken to ensure a player was not registered with another club within the league in a previous season.
- g. It is the responsibility of each club to check and monitor their list of registered players. It is also the clubs duty to inform the Secretary immediately of any errors which may arise.
- h. The Management Committee shall have power to refuse or cancel the registration of any player who is found guilty of undesirable conduct and to disqualify the player in question from participating in all games in the League.
- i. Applications by a player for TRANSFER must be made on the leagues prescribed form and posted or hand delivered to the League Secretary. Same day transfers as long as the form has been acknowledged by the league secretary (and not just pushed through the door) The form will require the consent of the club the player is leaving (this consent cannot be withheld unreasonably) and the application to be a Registered Player with the club the player wishes to join

Teams guilty of breaching any of the rules in paragraphs 4j to 4n listed below shall forfeit all points gained from such matches and maximum points shall be awarded to opponents.

- j. Any young cricketer who is under 13* years old must have written parental consent on their Registration Form. Anyone under 12* years old may only register for the League if they are a member of a County Squad. Players under 11* must not be registered.
(* for the purposes of this rule it is their age on 1st September in the year preceding the season).
- k. No team may play anyone who has not been properly registered.
- l. Players shall not play for more than one Member Club in either the North Devon League or North Devon League Cup without the prior agreement of the League Management Committee.
- m. No professional cricketer may play in the League unless that player was a bona fide amateur member of a North Devon League Club(s) for a period of at least three years before turning professional and no Club may field a Player they are paying to play cricket.
If a club believes that this rule has been breached, it should notify the Secretary in writing within 7 days identifying the player(s) concerned. The notification must include also their reason(s) for reporting it and proof of any breach. The player's status will then be determined by the League Management Committee whose decision shall be final.
- n. No team may play more than one player in a League game who is not an EU national

GUIDE TO COMPLETING THIS REGISTRATION FORM

SECTION 1—Must be completed in FULL by all players (In the case of NON-EU players the address entered will be their UK place of accommodation).

SECTION 2—Must be completed in FULL by Parent/ Guardian (In the case of Young Player).

SECTION 3—These details must be completed in addition to the details of Section 1 when a player is not an EU National (Overseas Player)

SECTION 4—This section is completed by all. Signed by the player and then counter-signed by the clubs delegate, Chairman, Secretary, Captain to confirm the clubs acceptance of the player being registered for the club.

SECTION 5—This section is only to be completed when registration of a player is required on The day of a match. Both the Applying Captain and the opponent Captain must sign. It is very important to remind the Applying Captain to return the registration form to League Secretary.
